Booth space is limited and is on a first come, first serve basis. **Business Booths will receive a 10X10 space along our event entrance. In an effort to curb costs for our 2010 Festival, no booth, table or chairs will be available.**

All items you wish to give away to festival patrons must be approved by the Pittsburg Seafood Festival Committee. ***No food or beverage give-aways, including water, are allowed to be given to festival goers.*** In order to qualify you must be accepted by the Seafood Festival Committee and agree to follow all rules and guidelines of the Seafood Festival set by the Pittsburg Seafood Festival Committee.
